

Product protocol Keno^mix



STEP 1

Add the activator to the product, Mix the product during 5 min, turn upside down and shake well. Wait 1 hour before use.



STEP 2 Dip the whole length of the teats. The teat dip disinfects and conditions the teat skin.



STEP 3

Cow is protected until next milking time. Additional hygiene practice: avoid cow lying on the floor immediately after milking.

MATERIAL

- Keno™mix
- Dip Cup or Pure Dipper

TEAT SKIN EVALUATION SCORES



SCORE 1 Teat skin is smooth, free from scales, cracks or chapping.



SCORE 2 Teat skin shows some evidence of scaling.



SCORE 3 Teat skin is chapped. Some small warts may be present.



AB REDUCTION

SCORE 4 Teat skin is chapped and cracked. Redness, indicating inflammation is present. Numerous warts may be present.

TEAT END EVALUATION SCORES



SCORE 1 Teat end sphincter is smooth, with no evidence of irritation.



SCORE 2 Teat end has a raised ring.



SCORE 3 Teat end sphincter is roughened with slight cracks, but no redness is present.



SCORE 4

Teat end sphincter is inverted with many cracks, giving a "flowered" appearance. Teat end may have old but healing scabs.

CID LINES
